



# Student Match Racing Invitational 23-24 March 2024

## Amendments to the Sailing Instructions

## Amendment 1

The following changes are made to Section 8 of the Sailing Instructions:

- 8.2 This Sailing Instruction is deleted. RRS C11 Applies.
- 8.4 The latest time for a warning signal on the last day of racing shall be 1700.
- 8.8 The intended first signal is 0853.
- 8.14 In the event of unfavorable conditions or unforeseen circumstances, in order to award an event victor, 75% of the round robin must be completed.





### Amendment 2

Addendum B - Race format is amended to read.

#### Stage 1 - Round Robin

- (a) There will be a Round Robin Series consisting of 8 teams.
- (b) Each team is scheduled to sail every other team at least once.
- (c) The top four placed skippers shall progress straight to Stage 3.

#### Stage 2 - Playoffs

(a) The remaining skippers shall sail a round robin to determine 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th place.

#### Stage 3 - Semi Finals

- (a) The top four skippers shall sail a semi final series.
- (b) The skipper finishing first in Stage One shall select their opponent when requested by the RC to do so. The remaining two skippers shall race each other.
- (c) A best of 3 series shall occur.

#### Stage 3 - Petite Finals

- (a) Based on semi final results only, the bottom two placing boats shall sail a best of 3 series to decide 3rd place.
- (b) The higher placed skipper from Stage 1 of the two skippers will be starboard entry in the first match.

#### Stage 4: Finals

- (a) Based on semi final results only the top two placing boats shall sail a best of 5 final.
- (b) The higher placed skipper from Stage 1 of the two skippers will be starboard entry in the first match
- (c) If both teams request and are in agreement boats may be swapped between matches in the final series. The OA has final discretion and may override this request.
